The acting intensive brings together a select company of dedicated students who are interested in immersing themselves in the study and production of a play. Participants will receive over 80 hours of dedicated training and performance time. They will produce and perform an hour long student version of a currently running White Heron main stage show (The Tempest) and shadow their Equity counterparts. This unique format affords students the opportunity to receive valuable mentoring and instruction from industry professionals.

Students will also create their own production team and be assigned to one of four major disciplines (directing, costume design, stage management, or admin & marketing), and they will follow this track through the entire rehearsal and production process. Additionally students will participate in Master Classes, focusing on technique and craft, lead by both Nantucket Theatre Institute staff and members of the White Heron Equity Theatre Company.

In Addition Participants Will:

- Attend, and when appropriate participate in WH production meetings for a main stage show
- Run their own production meetings for their student production
- Attend occasional WH rehearsals and engage in conversations with their WH Equity actor counterpart to discuss character development and bond over the rehearsal process
- Be assigned to a practical discipline and follow that thread throughout the rehearsal and production process (i.e. costume, set, stage management etc.)
- Participate in rehearsals for their student performance of a Main Stage show
- Participate in Master Classes lead by professional educators, Equity actors, and industry
  professionals. Classes may include topics such as "staying true to the text", "freeing the
  voice and movement of the actor" and "exploring the foundation of acting as a craft"
  through the exercises of Uta Hagen and other giants.
- Have assigned solo studio time private instruction in acting
- Keep a journal, recording their experiences and breakthroughs
- Commit to a strict rehearsal & production schedule (15-20 hr./wk more during tech week)
- Find that NTI staff and WHTC guest artists all have a student centered approach to their instruction

The Music, Theatre & Dance intensive is a new and exciting partnership with the Nantucket Music Center. Together NTI & NMC will help students take the world of musical theater and break it down into its three foundational parts (music, theatre and dance). Over 75 hours of dedicated training and performance time will be spent exploring the musical theater audition process, and mastering skills such as sight singing, accents, physical extension (stretching) and improv. All of these skills will help students confidently engage in the audition and rehearsal process.

The remaining time in the program will be spent introducing students to new material (shows, songs, and choreography styles) to help them determine what fits their "type" best. This program will culminate in two evenings showcasing the talents of both NTI (performers) & NMC (pit ensemble) students. Each student's progress and talent will be displayed through dialogue, song and choreography.

In Addition Participants Will:

- Join the Practical Theatre students to participate in Master Classes lead by professional educators, Equity actors, and industry professionals. Classes may include topics such as "staying true to the text", "freeing the voice and movement of the actor" and "exploring the foundation of acting as a craft" through the exercises of Uta Hagen and other giants.
- Have assigned solo studio time private instruction in acting, singing and/or dance
- Participate in rehearsals for their student performance showcases
- Keep a journal, recording their experiences and breakthroughs
- Leave the program with a folder of working material (songs & monologues) for future auditions
- Commit to a strict rehearsal & production schedule (13 18 hr./wk more during tech week)
- Find that NTI staff, and guest artists from WHTC and NMC all have a student centered approach to their instruction
- Receive a 10% discount on up to three additional private lessons at NMC\* (\*subject to availability)

## **Billing Information**

Once you are offered a position in the *practical theatre* program you will have 7 days to officially accept your enrollment and pay your tuition in full or authorize your payment schedule. ## Refund Policy

Tuition is NON-REFUNDABLE unless we decide to fill your spot. If we fill your spot the policy is as follows:

Before May 1st, we will refund 100% of your tuition minus a 10% administration fee.

May 1st - June 15, we will refund 50% of your tuition. The other 50% will be converted into

a tax deductible donation that will support future NTI immersive programming.

June 15 and after, we will refund 0% of your tuition. 100% of your tuition will be converted into a tax deductible donation that will support future NTI immersive programming.
